Directions

You've got your tickets and your tent's all packed. Now, how do you get to the festival?

The festival is held at the Larmer Tree Gardens, which is just off the A354 between Salisbury and Blandford, OS Ref ST940170.

From the South - on the A354 look for brown heritage/flower signs for Larmer Tree Gardens which start 13 miles SW of Salisbury and 9 miles NE of Blandford.

From London, West and the North - from the A303 take the A350 to Shaftesbury then A30 towards Salisbury. After approximately 3 miles (on reaching Ludwell) turn right at the signs for Larmer Tree Gardens and continue to follow brown heritage/flower signs.

Sat Nav

The festival site shares a postcode with a neighbouring village, and Sat Nav will send you in completely the wrong direction. Keep your journey quick and simple and help us keep our neighbours happy by following the directed route and brown heritage/flower signs.

When can I arrive?

The festival is open from 3pm on Wednesday 13th July and from 9am on Thursday 14th-Sunday 17th. Your ticket is valid for the dates on it only. For example, if you have a 3-day ticket you **may not** arrive on Thursday night. (Please don't arrive early as we won't be able to let you in - for info about an alternative campsite in a nearby village call Steven Judd 01725 552563.) Please note no new arrivals can be admitted to the festival after 10.30pm on any night.

When you arrive you'll be met by our Arrivals Team, who will check your tickets and direct you on where to park and camp. After setting up camp, you can swap your ticket for a wristband at the Wristband Exchange situated next to the entrance to the Village.

Camping Info...

Our award winning toilets, free hot showers, ample water points, café, shop and 24-hour security will make your camping experience a happy and relaxing one. Camping is free and valid for the date/s on your ticket only. Please don't turn up the night before your ticket is valid, as we won't be able to let you onto the site. The Larmer Tree campsites are right next to the festival site. You can camp on the nights you have a valid ticket for in either the tent field or the caravan and campervan field. New areas in the tent field this year - Quiet Camping, Family Camping and General Camping – so pick the one that suits you best! Mr Trolley will be providing a trolley hire service to help you carry all your stuff from your car to your camping spot and back. There will be a hire point near the car park where you can hire a trolley (charges apply), load up and ease into the festival without straining your back! You can afford to lie in a little, as you can camp until 11am the morning after your ticket expires. The campsites close at midday on Monday 18th July - remember to book your ride to Salisbury station on the Big Green Coach (fare is £8 per person and you can book your seat by visiting the Info Tent).

Please don't bring valuables with you unless absolutely necessary and take advantage of our secure Larmer Lock-Up to store away your cash, other valuables and bags or musical instruments you don't want to carry with you all day. This service is operated on a voluntary donation basis and is run by an experienced team from Birmingham Friends of the Earth, open 24 hrs a day. You can also charge your mobile at the Lock-Up but remember to bring your phone charger. There is a cash machine onsite so you don't need to bring lots of cash with you (debit cards only and charges apply). Inside the campsite you'll find Yogi Patel's Corner Shop and Haslemere Health Foods, selling essentials for your camp kitchen.
