

CONDITIONS OF TRADING

Larmer Tree Festival 14th-18th July 2010

The Secret Garden

J & J Events Ltd (hereafter known as The Festival) grants The Therapist (hereafter known as The Therapist) licence to trade at the Larmer Tree Festival on the following terms and conditions. Any violation of these terms and conditions will render this Licence null and void, and in that event, The Festival reserve the right to remove The Therapist and any of their possessions from the festival grounds without compensation or refund of the Licence fee.

- 1. Cost per Therapist** – £220 per standard tent size (10ft x 10ft) and under, with additional space purchased at time of application. For this The Therapist will receive one trader' wristband (not transferable under any circumstances) on arrival, and if required one free wristband for a helper/partner. All monies due must be paid with the application form (non-refundable if application accepted). The festival always sells out; therefore any additional family, friends and children (who will be arriving with the therapist on Wednesday) must purchase tickets with this application - please note you cannot camp without a ticket.
- 2. Therapist charges and hours** – The Therapist may charge £35 maximum for 1 hour, £20 maximum for 30 minutes. The Therapist agrees to be available for sessions for a minimum of 25 hours between Wednesday and Sunday. Please also see clause 3.
- 3. Festival times** – The garden will be open from 6pm-11pm on Wednesday 14th and 9am-12.30am on Thursday 15th, Friday 16th, Saturday 17th and Sunday 18th July. The Therapist is free to trade within these hours. The Therapist is not permitted to leave before the end of the festival unless in case of an emergency.
- 4. Setting up times** – The Therapist may set up from 9am-midday on Wednesday 14th only.
- 5. Breaking down times** – For safety reasons, therapists wishing to leave on Sunday 18th July, vehicular access will only be allowed between 8-9pm. Therapists leaving on Monday 19th July may do so from 9am and MUST vacate the site by MIDDAY.
- 6. Insurance** – The Therapist will not be permitted on site if The Festival has not received a copy of The Therapist's Public Liability Insurance certificate for £2,000,000 (minimum) in advance. If The Therapist's PLI is due to be renewed just before the festival, the existing copy should be sent with application and a copy of the new certificate sent when available.
- 7. Vehicles** – No vehicles can be left in the Garden after set-up and The Festival reserves the right to restrict vehicular access if the ground is wet. The Therapist should contact the Festival Office before the application is sent if their vehicle is longer than 20ft.
- 8. Access to your stall** – Please note that in adverse weather conditions vehicular access restrictions may apply, making it likely that therapists won't be able to get as close to the Secret Garden as required. The Therapist should therefore ensure they can carry their own equipment.
- 9. Trading Restrictions** – Related products can only be sold by The Therapist with the prior agreement of The Festival, and will incur an additional charge.
- 10. Tent Size Restrictions** - Fee includes a standard tent size of 10ft x 10ft or less. For tents over this size The Therapist must pay an extra £1 per square foot on application. The Festival reserves the right to refuse permission for The Therapist to set up in the Secret Garden if their tent exceeds the size paid for in advance - no overflow space will be available.
- 11. Care of site** – Any damage to the site caused by The Therapist is to be paid for before leaving the festival. The Therapist agrees to leave the site in a clean and tidy condition and use the recycling facilities provided. NO fires of any kind are allowed, this includes cooking. The Therapist should respect the Secret Garden and take special care not to damage any of the plants, trees or shrubs.
- 12. Security** – The festival grounds are fenced. The Festival employs a professional 24-hour security company, but can accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to The Therapist's equipment, merchandise, vehicles or personal belongings.
- 13. Camping** – The Therapist has the choice of camping in the Artist's Campsite situated within the festival site and adjacent to The Village, or in the main campsite which is just outside the festival site. The Therapist's guests can only camp in the Artists' Campsite if they are camping for the FULL 5 days. NB: NO cooking will be allowed in the Secret Garden at anytime.
- 14. Noise** – The Festival reserves the right to reduce or curtail any excess noise created by The Therapist if it is deemed to be affecting other therapists or festival activities.
- 15. Power** – The Festival will supply power for lighting only and must be requested upon application.
 - a) The Therapist will need to supply a lamp/light.
 - b) All cable should be properly secured and not constitute a trip hazard.
 - c) All electrical equipment should be maintained and tested for electrical safety in accordance with the Regulations for Electrical Installations (BS7671) and should display up-to-date PAT certification.
- 16. Candles** – The Therapist may use candles (either as lighting or in oil burners) only if enclosed within secure and stable non-flammable containers, eg wide-bottomed jam jars. Naked flames are not permitted.
- 17. Fire** – The Therapists must supply a 5kg dry powder fire extinguisher in case of fire.
- 18. Water** – There will be a water supply within walking distance of the Secret Garden.
- 19. Equipment** – The Therapist's tent and décor must be fire-proofed. The Festival does NOT supply stall equipment, tents, tables or chairs.
- 20. Dogs/pets** – With the exception of guide dogs, STRICTLY no animals are allowed in the festival grounds, or on the campsite.
- 21. Smoking** - Due to the smoking ban The Therapist must be aware that it is illegal to smoke anywhere that is enclosed or undercover.
- 22. Agreement** – The Therapist agrees to abide by the above clauses 1-21 and indemnify The Festival and its designated employees against any claim, loss or liability arising from a breach of the above clauses/regulations.
